Getting to Highland Hall, Waldorf School, the new San Fernando Valley Woodworker's meeting Location

What should seem simple has one glitch: the area where the school is located is a bit of a GPS's Bermuda Triangle. Even using a new phone's GPS guidance, you "may" be directed to go up Paso Robles Ave. Do not do that. Whether coming from the west (from Amestoy Ave) or from the east (Balboa Ave), simply go the Highland Hall, Waldorf School, turn South onto the driveway, past the gate, park, and join the woodworking activities.

* Directions from the 405 Freeway heading north: Exit Nordoff, turn left. Go 1.7 miles and turn right on Balboa Bd. Take the 3rd left onto Superior Street. Go 1.5 blocks and turn left into driveway.

* Directions from the 405 Freeway heading south: Exit Devonshire, turn right. Go 1.7 miles and turn left on Balboa Bd. Go about .8 miles and turn right on Superior Street. Go 1.5 blocks and turn left into driveway.

* Directions from the 118 Freeway: Exit Balboa Blvd. Head south (away from mountains) and go 2.2 miles. Turn right on Superior Street. Go 1.5 blocks and turn left into driveway.





Parking

We have three different locations for parking:

- 1. If you are strong and able, please park in the bottom parking lot.
- 2. If you want a shorter walk, park along the hill.
- **3.** If you're carrying years and/or have a lot of stuff to carry into the room, park in the basketball courts on top.

Please respect these guidelines.

Getting to the shop
